# The Corporation and Community

The Monroe-Gregg School District is just south of interstate 70, approximately 30 minutes from downtown Indianapolis. The district is composed of Monroe and Gregg Townships in rural Morgan County.

The proximity to Indianapolis and interstate 465 makes all the cultural, educational, and shopping available in the greater Indianapolis area an easy drive. Additionally, the offerings of Bloomington and Indiana University, IUPUI, University of Indianapolis, Indiana State, Butler, and Franklin College are within an easy commute.

In addition to a traditional comprehensive curriculum we belong to the Area 31 Vocational School of Wayne Township in Marion County and the West Central Special Educational Co-op for which Wayne Township serves as the LEA. Other special programs that we offer include special education pre-school, advanced placement classes, alternative education programs, Robotics, Project Lead the Way, DECA, FFA, STEM, Radio/TV Broadcasting and Ag Science.

The district operates its own transportation fleet. We are running 25 regular routes, two special education routes, and two vocational route.
