Monroe Gregg School District Covid19 Health Plan 2022-2023

(These guidelines are subject to change per the CDC, Indiana Department of Health or Morgan County Board of Health)

The goal of the health services department of Monroe Gregg Schools is to keep our students and staff healthy throughout the entire school year within the guidelines given to us.

Covid 19 Postitive Staff and Students- Will be required to isolate at home for 5 days from the day of test and may return on day 6 but must wear a mask while at school on days 6-10.

Masks- Masks will no longer be required daily except for the following situations.

- Individuals who have tested positive and are returning to school on days 6 through day 10.
- If your student attends Area 31 they will be required to follow the guidelines for attending classes on that campus.
- Students attending other schools or locations for athletic, academic, band, choir, or club competitions or performances and field trips must comply with mask requirements for that facility or location.
- Masks will be REQUIRED on all school buses to and from school. (per federal mandate). This includes all buses to and from extra-curricular activities such as athletics events, band, choir competitions, academic competitions, and field trips.

<u>Illness-</u>Covid 19 is still present and new cases continue to be reported. Please keep your student at home if they are experiencing any of the following symptoms

- Fever greater than 100.4 degrees
- Sudden loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Headache (especially when accompanied by a fever)
- Cough or shortness of breath
- Nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, and abdominal pain

<u>Covid- 19 testing-</u> If your student has been tested for Covid-19 your student must stay home until you receive the results.

<u>Quarantine/ Close Contact-</u> There will be minimal contact tracing done in the school. If a positive case is reported to the school you will still be notified that you student was exposed so you can monitor for symptoms but we will no longer quarantine close contacts.
